## PREPOSITIONS

### What are prepositions?



A preposition is a word which sits before a noun and indicates the relationship between the noun and any other words of the sentence.

#### **Examples:**

- I. Abhishek is **from** our village.
- 2. A ball **for** the dog.
- 3. The gift is *inside* the box.
- 4. He threw a coin into the pond.

**Common Prepositions:** above, about, across, against, along, among, around, at, before, behind, below, beneath, beside, between, beyond, by, down, during, except, for, from, in, inside, into, etc.

### Preposition of Time

Prepositions of time show the relationship of time between the nouns to the other parts of a sentence.

On, at, in, from, to, for, since, ago, before, till/until, by, etc. are the most common preposition of time.

#### Examples:

- I. He left the office at 6PM.
- 2. My grandfather was born in 1906.
- 3. We're going to watch a movie on Friday night.
- 4. I was waiting for your call since Monday.



### Preposition of Place/Direction

Prepositions of place show the relationship of place between the nouns to the other parts of a sentence.

On, at, in, by, from, to, towards, up, down, across, between, among, through, in front of, behind, above, over, under, below, etc. are the most common prepositions of place/direction.

#### Example:

- I. He found the phone *under* the tree.
- 2. She is **from** South Africa.
- 3. Please keep the books **on** the shelf.
- 4. Rahul is at his friend's home.
