














What are verbs? (क्रिया)

Verbs are the action words in a sentence that describe what the subject is doing.

Let's see some examples.

- The woman painted a picture.
- 2. We are **studying** biology.
- 3. The dog runs and jumps.

Some verbs also give the idea of existence, of state, of "being". For example, verbs like **be**, **exist**, **seem** and **belong** all convey state.












TYPES OF VERBS















Stative Verbs



A stative verb (or state verb) describes a **state of being**. This is usually something that does not change over a period of time.

Let's see some examples.

- I. I have a huge fan following.
- 2. I like cheese.
- 3. The elephant weighs a ton.

Note: We cannot usually use the continuous tenses with stative verbs.

I am having a huge fan following. (Incorrect)













Main & Helping Verbs

Main verb is a verb that expresses an action. It gives the major information in terms of nature of the action.

Helping (Auxiliary) verb give major information in terms of an the time of the action, not the nature of action.

Ex. Is, am, are, was, were, being, been, will be, has, had, having, will have, does, did, will do, etc.

Examples:

- I. Bindu is doing his homework.
- 2. Chintu has been running every day for a month.
- 3. Pawan wasn't dancing for an hour.

Transitive Verbs



Transitive verbs require an **object** to complete their meaning.

Let's see an example:

"I bought."

This sentence is incomplete because **bought** is a transitive verb. You need to tell what was bought?

More examples: Kick, give, carry, climb, kiss, take.











Intransitive Verbs



Intransitive verbs cannot have a direct object after them.

The subject is doing the action of the verb and nothing receives the action. An intransitive verb does not pass the action to an object.

Example.

- I. He *laughed* loudly.
- 2. The baby **smiled.**
- 3. I **get up** early.

More examples of Intransitive verbs: live, die, cry, run, sleep


